

3.3 The scholar must maintain good academic standing (GPA \geq 3) and complete their studies within the given time frame.

3.4 Once an applicant has been accepted for a particular program of study, the scholar is expected to complete that program and cannot change to different program of study.

3.5 The scholar needs to apply for a Non-immigrant "ED" visa (Study Permit). Scholars entering Thailand on a tourist visa cannot enroll and may have their scholarship canceled.

3.6 Other terms apply as established by the Faculty.

4.1 A copy of an English proficiency certificate (valid within 2 years) with a minimum score as follows:

- TOEFL Paper Based score of 500, or
Computer Based score of 173, or
Internet Based score of 61, or
Institutional Testing Program score of 520, or

5.3 Transcript of the highest degree obtained, as well as a transcript of the Bachelor's degree.

5.4 Research description/plan in English (about 800 words).

5.5 A medical certificate (in English).
